A ribbon will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each grade.

In addition 1st place winners will receive a \$10 Amazon gift card & 2nd place will receive a \$5 Amazon gift card.

Winning projects will be kept over night and displayed on Sunday for the congregation of Immanuel Lutheran and can be taken home on Monday, January 25th. All other projects should be taken home after judging is over.
